



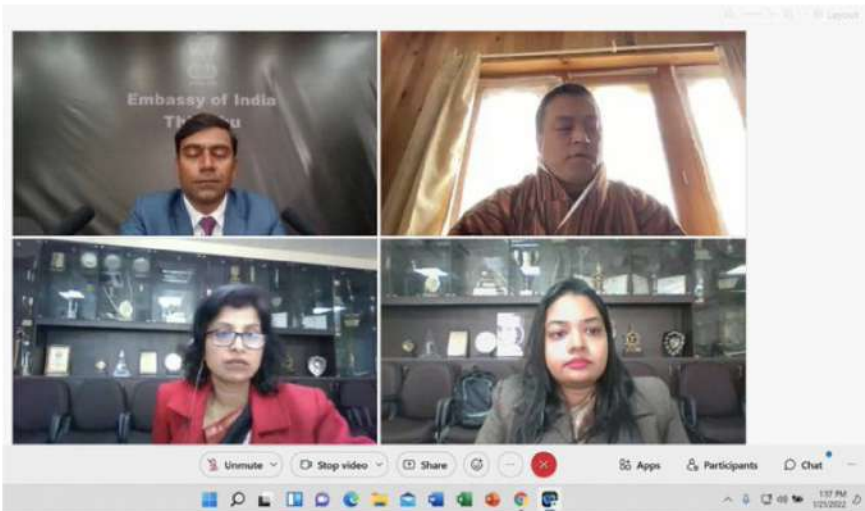
Valedictory session of a 14-week capsule style e-ITEC course for Bhutanese judges and legal officer
