

Ambassador of India Shri Jaideep Sarkar had recently visited Gasa Dzong Reconstruction Project and reviewed the progress. This is a GOI funded PTA Project. The cost of the Project is **Nu. 110 million**.



The Scope of the project included:

- Topographical survey of the site
- Historical research and documentation of the Dzong
- New construction of Drasha that includes Bath house, toilets, kitchen and dining hall and essential furniture for the monks
- Conservation and rehabilitation of the existing Dzong structure including:
 - Consolidation of the structure
 - Stone masonry walls
 - Deteriorated timber components
 - Re-layout of rooms as per requirement of the Rabdhey and the District Administration
 - Renovation and improvement of drainage system of the Dzong complex
 - Improve sanitary facilities inside the Dzong
- Overall site developments including
 - Renovation of courtyard, footpath, walls and entrance gate
 - Development parking space
 - Installation of firefighting system in the Dzong
 - Publication of the project report
 - Project supervision and management cost

As on date **72** % of the works have been completed. The project is expected to be completed by **June 2018**
