Subject: **Advisory on the exit of Indian Nationals from Bhutan**

As per the Department of Immigration (DoI), Ministry of Home and Cultural Affairs, RGoB; any Indian national travelling back from Bhutan, either on his own or with the support of his employer in Bhutan, needs to only fulfill following mandatory requirements for smooth exit : -

- (a) Carry with them RTPCR Negative test report that was done within last 72-hours;
- (b) Details of persons and vehicle in which they are travelling should be registered on CPMS Portal before the journey;
- (c) The Indian national should also carry his Valid Bhutanese Work Permit (WP) and Election Commission of India issued Voter Card or Valid Indian Passport to facilitate their exit at Immigration post.

2. With these requirements fulfilled, they can now directly exit from Bhutan without any documentation from the Embassy of India, Thimphu or CGI, Phuentsholing.
