Announcement of India Science and Research Fellowship (ISRF) Programme 2022-23

The Embassy of India is pleased to inform that the ISRF has launched the Fellowship Programme 2022-23 for Afghanistan, Bangladesh, **Bhutan**, Maldives, Myanmar, Nepal, Sri Lanka and Thailand researchers. A maximum of 10 fellows may be selected from each country to work in the Indian Universities and Research Institutions.

- 2. The Fellowship would provide opportunities for mid-career scientists/researchers, with minimum academic qualification as Ph.D/M.Tech/M.Sc. and 4-6 years research/teaching experience, to undertake research in Indian R&D institutions. The Fellowship would cover travel allowance (return air fare), sustenance allowance, contingency grants and medical facilities.
- 3. The ISRF Programme, launched in 2015, is part of India's initiatives to engage with neighbouring countries to develop S&T partnerships. This has provided opportunity to the young researchers from these neighbouring countries to get access to the state of art facilities available in the Indian institutes.
